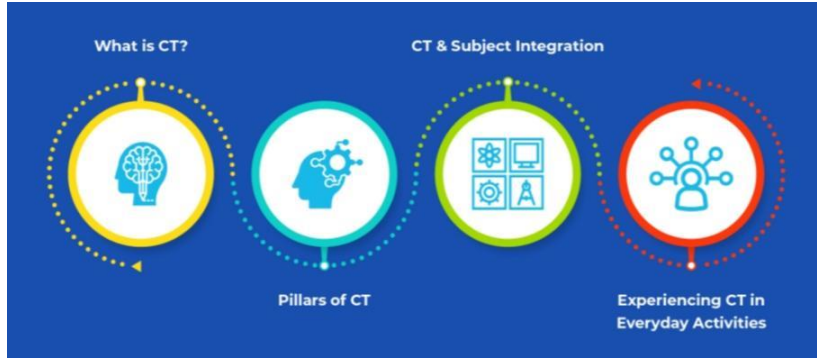


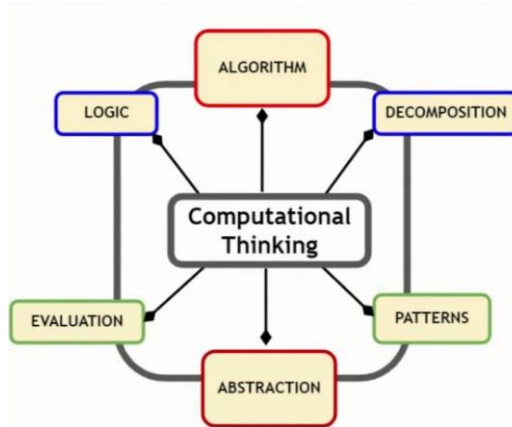

She explained Computational Thinking is a fundamental skill for everyone. It is a strategy for solving problems that can be applied to any field or situation. The concepts and approaches of computational thinking play a vital role in teaching. She also explained the pillars of computational thinking – Decomposition, Pattern matching, Abstraction and Algorithm with the help of examples. She showed sample exercises to be practiced in class and can be integrated with all the subjects.



The resource person requested the teachers to leave the pattern of traditional thinking and think out of the box for some innovative ideas to mould their children for the future needs.
